PRACTICAL INFORMATION – FIRST PROGRESS MEETING

Please find below the travel information to get from the airport to Wageningen (Campus or city centre - central bus station), and to get from city centre to the meeting venue (Orion building, Campus Wageningen University&Research).

Travel information Schiphol Airport – Wageningen Campus or city centre:

If you arrive in **Schiphol Airport (Amsterdam)** follow the indications to the arrival's hall and "Trains". There, buy a ticket for the train (before getting on the train!) to **EDE-WAGENINGEN (approx. 15.30 euro)**. Go to **platform 3** and take the first train with direction **Nijmegen (Intercity)**, please carefully check the electronic board on the platform to confirm platform and direction. Trains leaving at XX:00 or XX:30 will directly stop at station **Ede-Wgaeningen**.

If you miss this train you can take one from the same platform at XX:18 or XX:48. With this train you will have to change in Utrecht, and there get a train in the direction to Nijmegen (platform 19) which will stop at EDE-Wageningen.

Get out at **Ede-Wageningen** train station. Go down the stairs and **turn right**. Once out, you will find the bus stop for the **bus number 88 or 84**. Mention that you are going to **Wageningen Campus** (if you come directly from the airport to the meeting) or **Wageningen central station (if you arrive the day before and you want to go to city centre)**. You can buy a ticket on the bus itself. From the bus station it is about 5 min walk to most of the accommodation suggested below.

Visitors at WUR usually stay at Hotel Hof van Wageningen, please have a look at the attached map. Hotel **Hof van Wageningen (in case you are staying there) is located at Lawickse Allee 9**.

The total journey time is about 1h and 30 min.

Travel information Central station – Orion (Wageningen Campus)

Walk to Wageningen Central bus station. Take **bus number 84** or **bus number 88** in the direction of Ede-Wageningen. Buses go every 10 minutes. Get out at bus stop **Campus / Forum (BUS 84)** or **Campus/Atlas (BUS 88)** at the Droevendaalsesteeg.

The meeting venue is in **Orion (building 103), Bronland 1, 6708 WH Wageningen**. Check the following link for information about (and a picture of) Orion building: <https://www.wur.nl/en/location/Orion-building-number-103.htm>

The total journey is about 20 minutes.

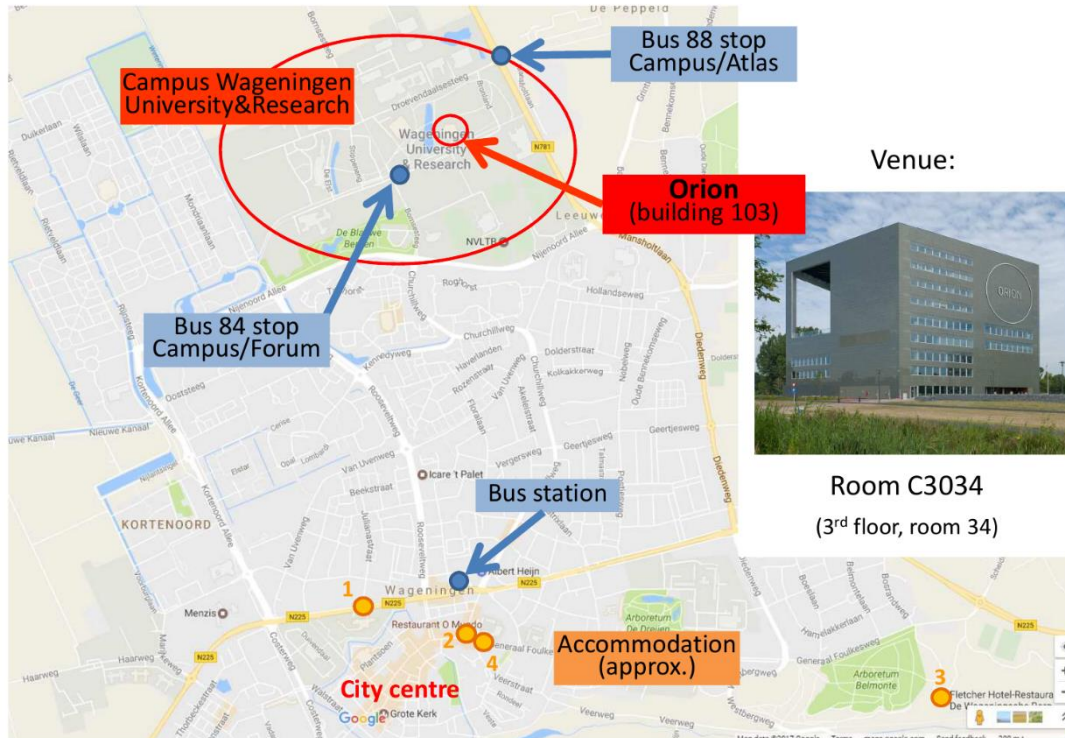

Accommodation information

Unfortunately there is no on-campus accommodation. We advise to look for accommodation nearby the city centre.

Find 4 main options below:

- 1) Hotel Hof van Wageningen (www.hofvanwageningen.nl). Nearby the city centre and bus central station. Perhaps the most common option among visitors at WUR.
- 2) Hotel de Wereld (www.hoteldewereld.nl). Nearby the city centre and bus central station. Historical building and location.
- 3) Hotel de Wageningsche Berg (<http://hoteldewageningscheberg.nl/en/>). Nice location, but a bit apart from city centre.

4) Shortstay Wageningen (<http://www.shortstaywageningen.nl/>). Nearby the city centre and bus central station. Kind of hostel, cheaper than previous options.

Other accommodation options exist, such as Bed&Breakfast, so feel free to search for these other options. In case of trouble finding accommodation, please let us know.

There is a bus connection between the city centre and the campus. Buses run every 10 minutes.
